Due to this information the New York State Police were contacted. In addition, all external doors were secured as a precaution. However, we did not go into lock down. As a further precaution recess was held indoors.

In a meeting with the State Police, it was determined the risk factor was low and the State Police would conduct a further investigation.

We would like to commend our MCS student in sharing this information. The student showed sound judgment and a great deal of maturity.

Please discuss this information with your student and how it pertains to internet safety. Rest assured any safety threats to our students and staff will not be tolerated. We will follow up with our communication with the New York State Police and any additional information will be shared with you.
